Neanderthals dietary habits are under the focus of a warm debate felt from extremely different views of their life-style. Supporters of a subsistence strategy based mostly on the consumption of meat now are more and more dealing with several discoveries occurred in last years which suggest that these hominins were targeted to exploit other resources in a way comparable to that of Anatomically Modern Humans in Western Eurasia. This evidence has much been integrated with data concerned with the exploitation of marine resources . Together with other caves from the South of Spain, Figueira Brava cave on the coast of Portugal is currently one of the most relevant evidence.
